

Machete Invitational at Tally Hills

Tournament Format:

This is a 1 day tournament with a maximum of 25 players over 3 rounds. You can play 1, 2 or 3 rounds depending on your time. You are welcome to spend Friday and/or Saturday night with us. You can set up a tent or put down an air mattress in the house or stay in a local Motel. You and your guest are invited to swim, play pool, foosball, eat and relax when you are not playing your round. No children or pets please. No smoking in the house please. 10am start also allows time to drive from out of town.

Payout:

We'll payout for each round and for the total scores.

Pros: We will pay the top third of the Pros, dividing the \$10 per round:

\$7 for each round, \$3 for total score

Ams: We will pay the top half of the Ams dividing the \$5 per round:

\$3 for each round, \$2 for total score

The winner's names will be engraved on our trophy machetes that are on display at the course.

What to bring:

Bring your own drinks, beer, coolers, towels and chairs. PLEASE don't bring any illegal substances or firearms to my home.

Course Description:

There are 3 courses layed out. The Black course is 5,700 feet long with 19 par 3 holes and the course record is -7. The Red course is 5,600 feet with 19 par 3 holes and the course record is -8. The Blue course is 4,800 feet long with 9 par 4 holes and the course record is -2. I have maps for each course layout. Each tee pad is marked with 2 bricks in the ground. The holes range from 170 – 850 feet. Some of the fairways cross, so we have to be careful of other players when we have tournaments. We have a combination of grass, concrete, dirt and wooden tee pads. We've held over 17 1-day "Machete Invitational" tournaments since the course was installed in July 2003. We call it the "Machete Invitational, since we used a lot of machete's to clear out the fairways in the woods. We also killed a few moccasins with our machetes. Since this is a natural environment, there are snakes in the creeks along with mosquitoes, ticks and posion ivy to be aware of.

Our home is located off of US 90 between Tallahassee and Monticello. If we aren't having a tournament, you have to call me before you can come by to play the course.

From Tallahassee, travel east on Mahan (US 90) and go under I-10, then travel about 11 miles and you'll pass Lake Miccosukee. Travel 1 more mile and turn right on Tally Hills Dr. after you see a white fence. Take the 1st left onto Lake View.

From Monticello, travel west on Washington St. (US 90) about 5 miles. Turn left onto Tally Hills Dr. After you see the white fence. Take the 1st left onto Lake View.

We are the 2 story brick house at the end of the cul-de-sac. Park near the fence, but not on the gravel drive.

You are welcome to tent camp in our back yard. I have a few tents and sleeping bags you can borrow. We have a full bathroom with a shower that is accessible from the pool patio or the garage. Bring your own toiletries and towels.
